3. MATTERS RAISED BY LOCAL RESIDENTS

The following matters were raised.

- Road Safety a resident said that road safety issues had been raised with Cheshire East Council but no action had been taken. It was noted that efforts had been made by the local PCSO, but issues still exist to do with horses and safety.
- Road Safety another resident said that some of the bigger horseboxes created issues (including those from South View). They had contacted South View, but received no response. It was said that enforcement is needed. Can monitoring cables be put in place.
- Road Safety councillors said that work had been done by former councillors on road safety and the state of the roads generally. But this work had come to nothing due to lack of response from Cheshire East Council. An issue is keeping people to the speed limit. There was a suggestion that the speed gun could be used more often. Will speak to the PCSO about training. It was also mentioned that hedges should be cut back and will ask Cheshire East to see if there is any assistance with this.
